

The Mona Bauhaus Project

- Why was it needed?
 - Lack of creativity and innovation
 - Over reliance on small number of large companies
 - Over dependence on inward investment
 - Risk averse
 - Grant dependent culture

What was Bauhaus?

- An avant-garde art and design school established in Germany by Walter Gropius in 1919. It was closed in 1933 by the Nazis
- Its purpose was to pursue new forms and new solutions to man's basic needs as well as his aesthetic ones. The Bauhaus' curriculum returned to fundamentals, the basic materials, the basic rules of design....









What is Mona Bauhaus?

- The appliance of Bauhaus philosophy and principles to economic development
 - Returning to the fundamentals, the basic materials
 - Produce prototypes for the mass market
 - Bringing together specialists from diverse backgrounds
 - Applying high design values
 - Adopting an innovative approach to new product development

The Mona Bauhaus Process

- Identify and catalogue resources
 - Natural Resources
 - Local Imagery (history, cultural, environmental)
 - Skills and manufacturing capacity
- Design Workshops
 - Recruit designers, retailers and manufacturers
 - Shortlist product ideas and prepare design briefs
- Develop Product Prototype
 - Commission private sector to develop products
