The Union of Walloon Women Farmers:

- 1. Is the women branch of the biggest Walloon Agricultural Federation: The Walloon Federation of Agriculture / Fédération Wallonne de l'Agriculture (FWA);
- 2. Is an association of continuous education.

Our members are women farmers but also rural women who come from all the provinces of Walloon Region (South part of Belgium)

The Union of Walloon Women Farmers works on different projects:

- Inform members about applicable laws and regulations
- Conduct debates on agricultural and rural issues to adopt the right position
- Lobby: defend the interest of women farmers and agriculture
- Organizing various forms of trainings





- Member of the Women's Commission COPA
- The Union works on solidarity projects with farmers groups from other countries or continents:
 - Exchanges between farmers;
 - Contacts between leaders;
 - Solidarity chain.

Ex: Burundi, Niger, Senegal, Romania, Vietnam, Cameroun, Brazil,...These projects are financed by regional money or with the collaboration of the Collective Food Strategies/ Collectif Stratégies Alimentaires.





The Union of women farmers developed:

- A social committee
- A support group for farmers who need help





The first aim of the Union of Walloon Women Farmers is the conservation of family farming.

This requires a SUFFICIENT LEVEL OF INCOME









At the UAW, we defined the family farming as

- « An agricultural structure in which the head of the agricultural holding and his/her family are:
- Economically independent;
- Make decisions;
- Supervise the management;
- Provide the essential part of the work and the capital.
